

2019-2020 TUITION & FEES



TUITION

Tuition is charged as an annual amount, but families may pay in one payment, or they may sign up for a 10-month or 11-month automated check-o-matic plan for a minimal monthly fee. The tuition payment plan begins in August; fees are withdrawn in July.

ENROLLMENT FEES

Enrollment fees serve as a deposit to hold a student's place, and they are used for various student activities throughout the year. This non-refundable deposit must be made with the enrollment contract to secure a child's place in the desired classroom.

SCHOOL FEES

These fees vary by grade level depending on types of books, supplies needed, field trip transportation needs, graduation costs, sleeping mats, etc. School fees are automatically deducted in July each year or upon enrollment for new families entering after July.

*The tuition amount will include an additional carrying charge of \$10 per month with the 10- or 11-month payment plan.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

The school applies a 5% discount to siblings.

FLEXIBLE TUITION

NHS offers a flexible tuition option to families with documented financial need based on an evaluation of eligibility. Families may apply for the flexible tuition option along with their admissions application, although no decision can be made until a student is accepted. LUNCH PROGRAM

Families have the option of purchasing lunch for their child at a cost of \$6-8 per lunch. New Horizon contracts with lunch vendors for this service.

EXTENDED CARE

Extended care is offered from 3:00 or 3:30 to 6:00 p.m. each day for an additional charge of \$185 per month. Families may drop off students at no charge from 7:30 to 8:00 a.m. each day. Families are billed on a monthly basis for the extended care. Late fees of \$15 per 15 minutes apply with late pick-up.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION & FEES

In addition to the Enrollment Fee which ALL students are required to provide as a deposit to reserve a child's space, the school charges annual tuition of which 100% is due at the start of school. Please note that no reduction shall be made for withdrawal after starting school.

Note: The tuition covers all educational services and resources for the student's enrollment at school except for lunch and uniform purchases. For international student applicants whose parents are in the United States for a temporary job contract, the parent must provide their contract term dates upon application for admission.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICE AND FEE

The school may provide bus transportation from home to school and back for a fee based on the number of students who are enrolled in the service. The availability of this service depends on meeting a minimum number of students living within close proximity to one another. Parents who are interested in this service should notify the Admissions Associate to reserve a space. Once the minimum is met, the school determines the transportation fee and provides the schedule for pick-up and drop-off. Families are expected to comply with timeliness to the schedule as well as the rules of the school and the bus company.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

Once students are enrolled, they will be assessed for their level of English language proficiency (this mainly applies for students in grades 1-8). Students may then be assigned to pull-out tutoring during the school day for 1-2 periods. There is no additional fee for these services.

LUNCH PROGRAM

Families have the option of purchasing lunch for their child. New Horizon contracts with lunch vendors for this service.

PARENT SERVICE HOURS

International families are not required to participate in this program. However, if families wish to purchase Scrip to help support the school or participate in any volunteer activities, they are welcome to do so.

TRANSITION ASSISTANCE

NHSP personnel are happy to work with each family to make the transition to a new environment easier for everyone.
