SUMMER CAMP/PROGRAM

It has been such a joy to plan for and conduct our NHSP Summer Camp each year for the past two years now. This would be Year 3 going into Summer 2020, and we are now facing a whole host of factors that will seriously affect our ability to successfully provide our interactive camp experience.

After careful consideration of the current health and safety concerns that are constantly changing, creating much uncertainty at this time, the administration has decided NOT to provide an on-campus summer camp. However, in view of the needs of both children and families to get a break from the regular school routine but still be engaged in fun and learning, we are putting together a plan for a **3-hour/day 4-Week Online Summer Program from July 6 – July 31** that provides fun and creative exploratory activities for Entering PK through Grade 6. The rate would be \$125 per week per student with a MINIMUM REQUIREMENT of 40 students.

We plan to share the revised program through email and through the Camp Brain Registration link sometime next week and would appreciate families making their decisions by **June 5**. This would allow us time to confirm if the program will be able to move forward. Those who have already registered for the regular summer camp will need to contact Ms. Klosterman at kklosterman@newhorizonschool.org to indicate whether they will be keeping their children in the program or will be requesting a refund.
